Philabundance Community Kitchen (PCK), an adult vocational training program for low-income adults, seeks prospective students for its next class, January 16 through the first week of May.

This 14-week program provides nearly 500 hours of culinary arts training and also offers exposure to guest chefs, catering opportunities, off-site internships and job placement services. In addition, retention services are offered for two full years to ensure that students maximize their training and maintain positive work ethics.
