Philabundance seeks volunteer drivers to assist our Grocers Against Hunger program. Volunteers are needed to pick up food from local grocery stores and deliver it to neighborhood agencies.

We are currently looking for volunteers willing to drive in Lower Bucks County and Northeast Philadelphia but if you are interested in this program and live in the Greater Philadelphia area we'd love to hear from you!

Volunteers Must:

- Be 18 years of age or older
- Have access to his/her own large vehicle; such as a van, SUV, or pick-up truck; Vehicle must be clean for transporting food
- Have a valid driver's license, clean driving record and valid auto insurance
 - Philabundance will run a MVR for each year that the volunteer participates
- Must be able to commit to a 2-3 hour shift, weekly or semi-weekly for at least six months. We hope to schedule volunteers with a specific agency and grocer to service each week but we are also looking for volunteers willing to be "on call" to help with unexpected donations.
- Able to lift up to 50 pounds
- Be willing to work in a group and enjoy communicating with diverse groups of people
